# Update on Lena and Emma's tasks:

Emma and Lena have met online for conversations based on "time to think" on Ecologies of Attention and Linguistic Bodies. Conversations are now online and some of the conversations are transcribed, too.

# Update on Cordula and Andrea's tasks:

Cordula and Andrea met for the second time on March 8th. They talked about their experiences regarding the writing practice on the 18th of February andthe complex notion of the 'public' or the 'public square' in digital times. They continued by sharing ideas on two books they are currently reading "Linguistic Bodies" and "En Tierra de Nadie" having the dimension of sound as a focus in mind.W (The latter book title also refers to an eponymous essay about the American-Mexican border by William Langewiesche describing the middle space of noisy high way occupied by transiting migrants.) Andrea and Cordula were pondering about the positionality of the foreigner, outsider and/or alien in the context of this project and in reference to the invitation in Granada.

The second half of their meeting focused on possible reading scores and prompts for the workshop in Granada. Cordula and Andrea created a mind map (available here) to better grasp the relational patterns that are at play while engaging in a situated and collective writing, reading, recording practice, see addendum. The map helped them to think about the agency of different reading prompts. Ideally, they concluded, the experience of reading together/alone and the testing of different prompts would give the participants an idea of the textorium in-process leading to the final presentation of the workshop.
